

THE SEASON OF LENT

We will be focusing on the Lord's Prayer (Matthew 6:9-13). Our worship services will be shaped each week with the specific petition of the Lord's Prayer: Holiness, God's Will/Kingdom, Daily Bread, Forgiveness, and Temptation. Each week will begin with a morning prayer to aid us in centering our thoughts, minds, and hearts to pray.

The Tulip is called the "Prayer Flower." Because no matter what direction it is growing or displayed, the stem will always bend the flower upward; Just as our prayers are directed upward.
